Use the Ohio Stops Fraud App

Available for IOS7 users who own the iPhone 4 or later models. To download the app, visit the Apple App Store via your mobile device or Apple computer; search for "Ohio Stops Fraud."

Tips or complaints of fraud in Ohio's governments may be made at any time by any public employee or private citizen. Fraud may be reported by using the Auditor of State's website at <https://ohioauditor.gov/fraud.html>, U.S. Mail, the Auditor of State's Fraud Hotline, and the Ohio Stops Fraud iPhone app.

[Ohio Revised Code Section 117.103](#) requires all public employers to notify employees of the methods of reporting fraud, including doing so anonymously. The Auditor of State's office has created a [Fraud Reporting Model Form](#) to help employers comply with these statuorial requirements.

Also established in ORC §117.103 is a public log of fraud reports, which includes the date of the report, the entity complained of, the nature of the complaint and the status of the review of the complaint.
