Child Medical Statement

The attached Medical Form is to be completed by your child's physician. A new physical is not required if it has been less than one year since the prior physical. In this case, you may take this form to your physician to fill out. Medical statements are good for 13 months after the exam date. If your child's medical statement is 13 months past the exam date, you are required to get a new physical and turn in a new form.

If you are unable to afford the cost for your child to see a doctor, attached is a pamphlet with a few Health Center options where you can get a wellness check for a discounted price based on your income.

We will accept the medical statement up to 30 days after the first day of school.

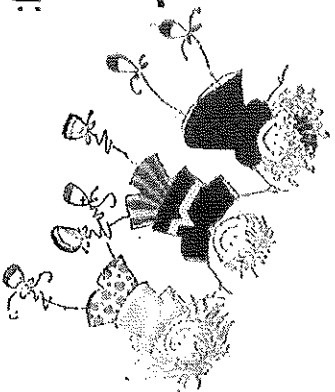
